COVID STATEMENT

Because of the current COVID risk here is the protocol:

It is exciting that all over our area groups including choral groups are meeting again. In order to keep rehearsals a safe environment we as many of our counterparts are observing protocols.

We will start with masks and be socially distanced as deemed necessary. We will make changes on a rehearsal – by – rehearsal basis. Statistics show that as of June 7, Jefferson County residents who are not vaccinated have a 69 per 100,000 chance of becoming infected. The risk of a COVID infection for those fully vaccinated based on CDC data from January to June is about 2 per 100,000. At the concert, at this time, we will not be wearing masks, but we will make decisions in the safest interest of our participants. **If you are concerned about the risk, please know we understand but encourage you to join us at a first rehearsal and then make your decision.** Please see the director for extenuating circumstances.
